The Hydro Pot Planting In A Hydro Pot



The Perfect
Wick Watering
System



Bring the included wick up through the largest hole in the bottom of the basket and pull enough up so that it lays against the side and slightly over the top of the basket



Use a knife to score about 1/2" of the bottom of the root ball so that you can remove this part. This will spur new root growth



Fill two thirds of the way up the basket with your soil mix. Then lay the wick onto this soil mix. Sprinkle with Marathon and Mycorrhizae if desired.



This is the root ball where you have removed the bottom portion you have scored. You can also loosely free up the roots around the edge if you desire.



Remove your plant from the smaller pot so that you can transplant into this larger one. Remove the flower so that the energy goes to roots and not blooms



Place the plant into the pot so that it rests on the wick and fill in around the plant carefully pressing the new soil down to slightly to compress it.



Fill the bottom of the Hydro Pot with your fertilizer water to just below the bottom of the basket.



Here is your plant in it's new larger pot, ready to grow.

The Hydro Pot utilizes a specially made wick to insure proper watering. Do not replace with yard or cotton wicks that can over water your plants. Replacement wicks, when needed, are available at world-of-streps.myshopify.com
